




## Tying a square mat or coaster




Set up a grid of 12 pins, then follow the instructions ... Clockwise -1 (rhs) to 7




Clockwise - 7 to 1, under to 2




Clockwise -2 to 6, under over to 8




Clockwise - 8 to 12, under over under to 3




Clockwise -3 to 5, under over under over to 9




Clockwise -9 to 11, under over under over under to 4




Clockwise -4 under over under over under over to 10



10 under over under over under to 4 (rhs)



Now double up, following the leads through (you could use a separate cord if you wish). Remove the pins at a convenient point, maybe even before doubling.



When finished doubling (or trebling), tighten the mat up gradually, being careful not to lose the "ends" at pins 1 and 4 - these ends can be cut to the edge of the mat when you are done.
